

Memorandum in the field of statistics, signed in Braşov



On January 16, 2012 the Memorandum of Understanding on Co-operation in Statistics between the National Institute of Statistics of Romania and the National Institute of Statistics of Bulgaria was signed in Braşov. The National Institute of Statistics of Bulgaria was represented by Associate Professor Mariana Kotzeva, PhD, President of the Bulgarian NIS, and the National Institute of Statistics of Romania was represented by Prof. Vergil Voineagu, PhD, President of the Romanian NIS.

This memorandum aims at establishing a framework for the joint development and implementation of co-operation programmes and projects in the field of statistics.

According to the signed document, the two parties will “promote and develop co-operation in relevant statistical fields based on mutual benefit and support”. The statistical co-operation between the parties will also consist of “the exchange of experience and information with regard to the methodological, organisational and technological issues concerning the production and dissemination of statistical data, missions and study visits, the organisation of training courses and working groups, the exchange of statistical publications and methodologies, as well as the implementation of joint projects in the field of statistics, including research and development projects”, said Vergil Voineagu, President of the Romanian NIS.

The new memorandum also includes the possibility of collaboration agreements between the County Statistical Divisions of Romania and the District Divisions of Bulgaria, as Mariana Kotzeva, President of the Bulgarian NIS, pointed out. In this respect, the Braşov County Statistical Division and the Veliko Trnovo Statistical Division may sign a co-operation agreement.
