Average earning^{*)} in April 2010

In April 2010, gross nominal average earning was 1973 lei, by 4.9% less than in the previous month.

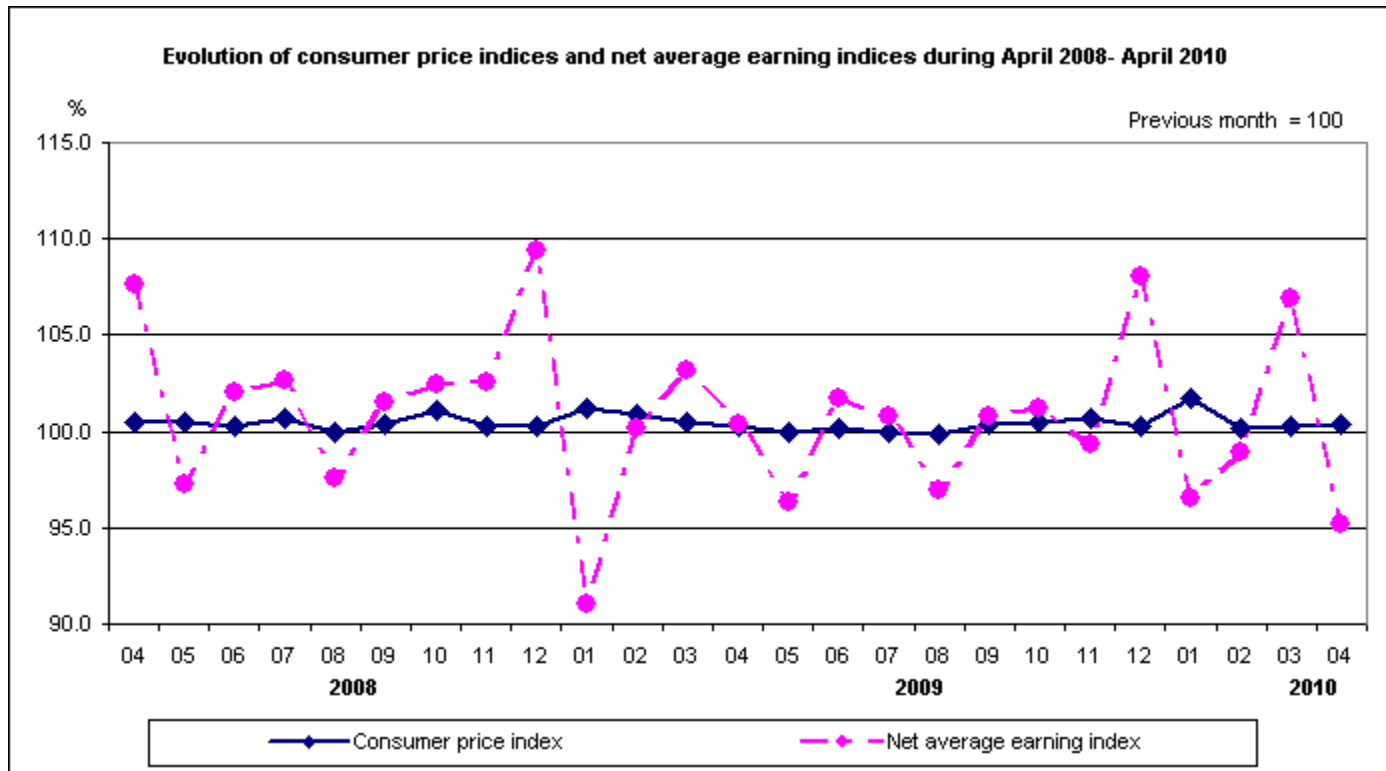
Net nominal average earning was 1436 lei, decreasing as against the previous month by 73 lei (-4.8%).

Higher values of net nominal average earning were registered in the activities of financial intermediation (3620 lei) and the lowest ones in hotels and restaurants (803 lei).

Earning in comparison with consumer price evolution

Real earning index for April 2010 as against the previous month, calculated as ratio between net nominal earning index and consumer price index was 94.9%.

As compared to October 1990, real earning index was 125.3%, by 6.8 percentage points lower than that registered in March 2010.



During the year, earning fluctuations are registered being mainly determined by the 13 th salary and holiday bonuses (December, March/April). They influence the growths and falls according to the

period when granted, finally leading to the diminish of monthly earning fluctuations at level of the whole year.

April 2010 as compared to March 2010

In April 2010, in most of economic activities, **level of net average earning was lower than in the previous month**, when occasional bonuses were granted (yearly premiums², the 13th salary for 2009², Easter bonuses), amounts from net profit and from other funds (gift tickets). At the same time, the fall of net average earning level in April was determined by non achievements of productions, technical unemployment and financial difficulties.

The most significant falls of net average earning were registered as follows:

- by 30.9% for tobacco products;
- between 15% and 17% for financial intermediations, coal and lignite mining;
- between 10% and 14% for crude petroleum and natural gas extraction, other products of nonmetallic minerals, other extractive activities, education;
- between 8% and 10% for publishing, water collection, purification and distribution, general government, wood processing (including wood and cork products, except furniture; straw articles and of other vegetal knitted materials), basic pharmaceuticals and pharmaceutical preparations, electric equipment;
- between 6% and 8% for mail and courier activities, textiles, rubber and plastic products, computers and electronic and optical products, beverages, other industrial activities n.e.c..

Rises of net average earning in April 2010 as against the previous month were registered only in few economic activities and were determined by occasional premiums (including Easter bonuses), achievements of products or higher cashing as follows:

- by 8.1% for real estated transactions, respectively by 6.8% in activities auxiliary to financial intermedation, insurance and pension funding;
- between 4% and 5% for telecommunications, cinema production, video and TV programs (including audio recordings and musical publishing; programs broadcast), water transport, land transport and transport via pipelines.

Budgetary sector registered falls of net average earning for education (-10.7%), general government (-8.6%), health and social assistance (-4.0%) as a result of granting in March in some units the amounts from other fundsi (incentives) and occasional bonuses (the 13th salary for 2009²), as well as because of withdrawing/ diminishing certain increases or of financial difficulties.

April 2010 as compared to April 2009

In comparison with April 2009, net nominal average earning increased by 2.0%. Real earning index as against the same period of previous year was 97.8%.

Methodological notes

1. Monthly data on earning and number of employees are obtained from the sampling statistical survey. For the sample size, it was taken into account to get some estimations of the main surveyed characteristics, to be affected by errors in the limit of +/-3% and guaranteed with a probability of 95%. Since January 2010, the sample includes 25000 economic and social units. Budgetary units are exhaustively included in the survey, exception local public administration units for which data at level of communal local councils are collected based on sample representative at county level (about 770 units). For economic sector, there were included in the survey the units with 4 employees and over, which represent 92.73% of total employees in this sector.

Objective of monthly statistical survey on earning is to evaluate the short term trends of monthly and hourly average earning per total economy and activity sector.

2. Data obtained from monthly statistical survey on earning and number of employees are **aggregated by homogeneous activity of units**; it means that public administration activity **does not include** all secondary activities carried out in central and local public administration, such as:

- social assistance,
- cultural, sport and recreation activities,
- landscape and building services,

- agriculture,
- water distribution, sanitation, waste administration, decontamination activities,
- construction,
- transport and storage,
- production and supply of electric and thermal energy, gas, hot water and air conditioning,
- renting and sub-renting real estate goods etc.

Information for secondary activities are each included in economic activities according to corresponding CANE Rev.2.

3. Information on „**budgetary sector**” should be carefully used, because data refer to statistics of economic activities (aggregated by homogeneous activity) **according to CANE Rev.2.** of public administration, education and health and social assistance (including private sector for education- about 3%, respectively health and social assistance - about 5%), excluding armed forces and similar staff (Ministry of National Defense, Romanian Intelligence Office, Ministry of Interior etc.).

These statistics do not take into account the financing type, their purpose being to provide information by economic activity according to CANE Rev.2.

Information corresponding to the financing type are administered the Ministry of Public Finances, according to the stipulations of U.G.O no. 48/2005, with later completions and modifications.

4. Concepts and definitions

Gross nominal earning includes salaries, respectively money rights and rights in kind for employees for the work effectively done (including overtime) according to salary type, increases and indemnities as percentage of salary or fixed amounts, other additions according to the law, amounts paid for time not worked (indemnities for rest leaves, and study leaves, holidays and other days off, amounts paid from salary fund for medical leaves), premiums, holiday bonuses and other amounts paid from salary fund according to normative documents or collective labour contracts, amounts paid from net profit and other funds (including equivalent value of lunch tickets).

Net nominal earning is obtained subtracting the tax from gross nominal earning, the employees' health contribution, the individual contribution of state social insurance and the employees' contribution to unemployment insurance budget.

Monthly average earning represents the ratio between amounts paid to employees by economic units in the reference month, no matter of period and average number of employees. Average number of employees represents a simple arithmetic mean based on daily number of employee in that month. Number of employees taken into calculation includes only persons who were paid for that month. There are not taken into consideration the employees in unpaid leave, strike, detached to work abroad and those whose labour contract agreement was suspended.

Gross nominal earning index is calculated as ratio between gross nominal average earning in current month and that of reference month, expressed in percentage.

Net nominal earning index is calculated as ratio between net nominal earning in current month and that of reference month, expressed in percentage.

Real earning index is calculated as ratio between net average nominal earning index and general index of consumer prices, expressed in percentage.
