Average earning^{*)} in May 2010

In May 2010, gross nominal average earning was 1962 lei, by 0.6% lower than in the previous month.

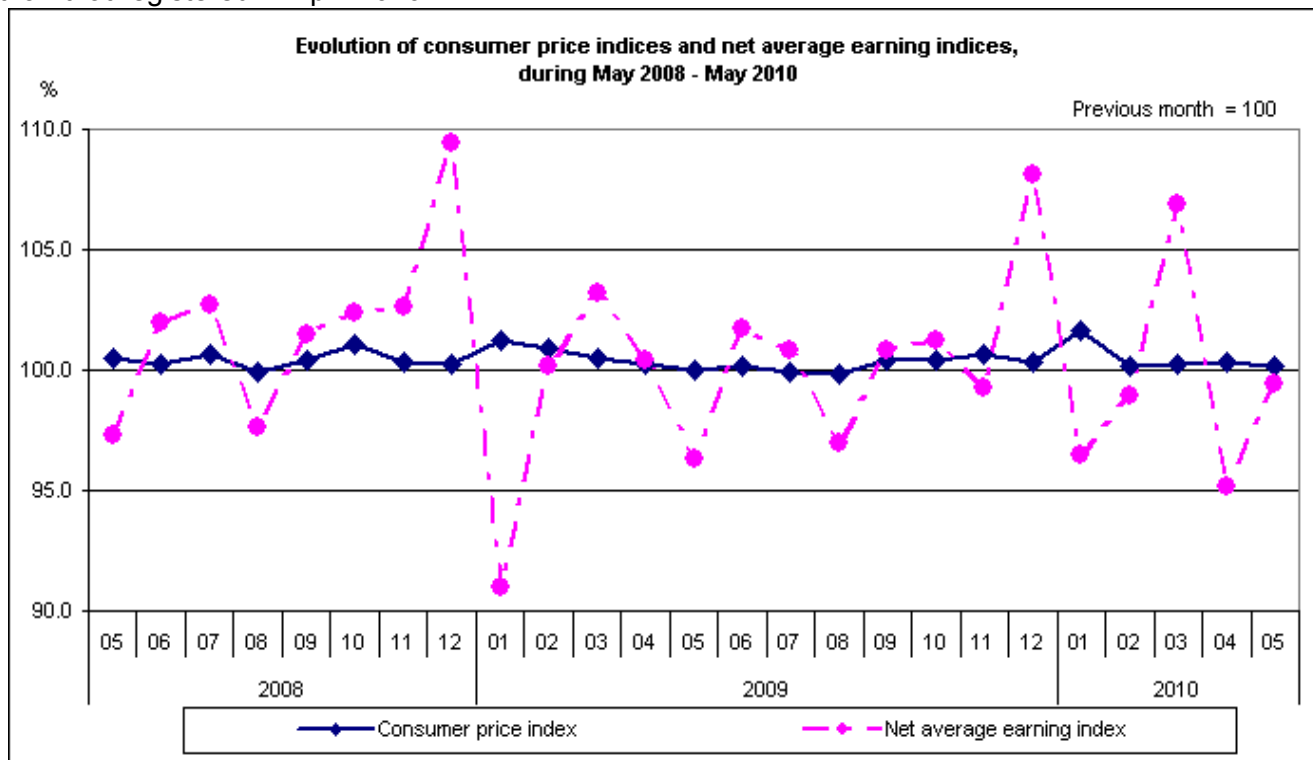
Net nominal average earning was 1428 lei, decreasing as against previous month by 8 lei (-0.6%).

The highest values of net nominal average earning were registered in activities of financial intermediation (3783 lei) and the lowest ones in hotels and restaurants (792 lei).

Earning in comparison with evolution of consumer prices

Real earning index for May 2010 as against previous month, calculated as ratio between net nominal average earning index and consumer price index was 99.3%.

In comparison with October 1990, real earning index was 124.4%, by 0.9 percentage points lower than that registered in April 2010.



During the year, earning fluctuations are registered, being mostly determined by the 13th salary and holiday bonuses (December, March/April). They influence growths and falls in keeping with the period they are granted, finally leading to the diminish of monthly earning fluctuations at level of the whole year.

May 2010 as compared to April 2010

Level of **monthly net average earning** in May 2010 registered slight differences as compared to the previous month, in keeping with the specific of economic activities.

Rises of net average earning were registered as a result of granting occasional premiums (including holiday bonuses), payment of rest leaves from salary fund, payment of sums from net profit and from other funds (including lunch tickets and holiday tickets), as well as achievement of production or higher cashing, return from unpaid rest leave or technical unemployment, as follows:

- by 1.4% for tobacco products;
- between 5% and 10% for crude petroleum and natural gas extraction, activities of services related to extraction, rubber and plastic products, cocking products and products from crude petroleum processing, other extraction activities;
- between 3% and 5% for storage and auxiliary transport activities, financial intermediation (except insurance and pension funding), metallurgy, air transport.

Falls of net average earning in May 2010 as against previous month were determined by granting occasional bonuses during March - April 2010 (including yearly premiums, bonuses and Easter bonuses), non achievement of production or lower cashing, technical unemployment and financial difficulties. **The most important falls of net average earning** were registered as follows:

- by 13.8% for telecommunications and by 12.0% for activities auxiliary to financial intermediation, insurance and pension funding;
- between 6% and 10% for real estate transactions, insurance, reinsurance and pension funding (except those of public social insurance system), other transport means, metal ores extraction, water transport;
- between 2% and 4% for other products of nonmetallic minerals, water collection, purification and distribution, coal and lignite mining, beverages, basic pharmaceuticals and pharmaceutical preparations, land transport and transport via pipelines, education, furniture, waste collection, treatment and disposal (including recovery activities of recycling materials, decontamination activities and services).

Budgetary sector registered slight rises of net average earning in health and social assistance (0.4%) and general government (0.3%), following the granting in May in some units occasional bonuses (holiday bonuses for 2010) and sums from other funds (incentives). In education, net average earning was by 2.4% lower in May than in April because of granting in the previous months in some units occasional bonuses (the 13th salary for 2009), as well as due to participation of employees in the strikes.

May 2010 as compared to May 2009

In comparison with May 2009, net nominal average earning increased by 5.3%. Real earning index as against the same period of previous year was 100.8%.

Methodological notes

1. Monthly data regarding earning and number of employees are obtained from a sampling statistical survey. For the sample size, it was taken into account to obtain some estimations of main surveyed characteristics, affected by errors in the limit of +/-3% and guaranteed with a probability of 95%. Starting with January 2010 the sample includes 25000 economic and social units. Budgetary units are exhaustively included in the survey, except local public administration units for which data at level of local communal councils are collected based on representative sample at county level (about. 770 units). For economic sector, there were included in the survey the units with 4 employees and over, representing 92.73% of total employees in this sector.

Objective of monthly statistical survey over earning is to evaluate short term trends of monthly and hourly average earning per total economy and activity sector.

2. Data obtained from monthly statistical survey regarding earning and number of employees are **aggregated by units homogeneous activity**; it means that public administration activity **does not include** all secondary activities developed in central and local public administration such as:

- social assistance,
- cultural, sport and recreation activities,
- landscape and services for buildings,
- agriculture,
- water distribution, sanitation, waste administration, decontamination activities,

- construction,
- transport and storage,
- production and supply of electric and thermal energy, gas, hot water and air conditioning,
- rent and sub rent real estate goods etc.

Information related to secondary activities are included in economic activities according to corresponding CANE Rev.2.

3. Information regarding „**budgetary sector**” should be used carefully because data refer to statistics from economic activities (aggregated by homogeneous activity) **according to CANE Rev.2.** of public catering, education and health and social assistance (including private sector for education - about 3%, respectively health and social assistance - about 5%), except armed forces and similar staff (Ministry of National Defense, Romanian Intelligence Office, Ministry of Interior etc.).

These statistics do not take into account the financing type, their purpose being to supply information by economic activity according to CANE Rev.2.

Information according to financing type are administered by Ministry of Public Finance, in keeping with the stipulation of Government Urgency Ordinance no. 48/2005, with later completions and modifications.

4. Concepts and definitions

Gross nominal earning includes salaries, respectively rights in cash and in kind for employees for the work effectively done (including for overtime) according to salary type applied, increases and indemnities as per cent of salary or in fixed amounts, other salary additions according to the law, amounts paid for time not worked (indemnity for rest leaves, study leave, holidays, other days off, amounts paid from salary fund for medical leaves), premiums, holiday bonuses and other amounts paid from salary fund according to normative documents or collective labour contracts, amounts paid from net profit and other funds (including equivalent value of lunch tickets).

Net nominal earning is obtained decreasing the tax from gross nominal earning, the contribution of employees for social health insurance, the individual contribution of state social insurance and the contribution of employees to unemployment insurance budget.

Monthly average earning represents the ratio between amounts paid to employees by economic units in the reference month, irrespective of the period and average number of employees. Average number of employees represents a simple arithmetic mean calculated based on daily number of employees in the respective month. Number of employees taken into calculation includes only persons who were paid for that month. There are not taken into consideration employees in unpaid leave, in strike, detached to work abroad and those whose labour contract/agreement was suspended.

Gross nominal earning index is calculated as ratio between gross nominal average earning of current month and that of reference month, expressed in per cent.

Net nominal earning index is calculated as ratio between net nominal average earning of current month and that of reference month, expressed in per cent.

Real earning index is calculated as ratio between net average earning index and general index of consumer prices, expressed in per cent.
